

### Keep It Moving

he Bible is full of testimonies of people who overcame great odds, uncertainty, and fear to move forward in their walk with the Lord. His established track record of delivering His people from challenging circumstances speaks for itself.

This is why adversity-free living shouldn't be your goal. You aren't called to avoid trouble; you're called to overcome it. Sometimes, doing the will of God means standing and resisting the urge to quit and trusting the outcome to the Lord.

When the children of Israel were pursued by Pharaoh's 600 chariots, they had no idea what the Lord could do. They were mad at Moses for delivering them from Egypt thinking they were going to die in the wilderness. They wanted to go back to Egypt because they preferred living with a familiar devil rather than following a strange God. I love the Lord's almost nonchalant response to their wailing in Exodus 14:15:

And the LORD said to Moses, "Why do you cry to Me? Tell the children of Israel to go forward." (NKJV)

The Lord's answer to them reveals that our breakthrough is oftentimes found in doing what we can do. God expected Israel to take the first step forward and for Moses to use the staff he already had in his hands as their weapon of deliverance to split the Red Sea.

You'll never know who you are and what God can do until you've walked with Him through the valley. Jesus wants you to know Him in the difficult places. You can't learn that by sitting in the pews or streaming. It only comes through experience.

If you're in a season of adversity, feeling plagued by problems, the Lord wants

you to know that it doesn't necessarily mean you're being punished. You could be under attack because the enemy knows how valuable you are and doesn't want you to move forward with God. He wants to paralyze you with fear.

But just because fear is present doesn't mean you're losing. The presence of faith is not the absence of doubt. It's possible to believe in God and still feel nervous. You don't have to be ashamed of your humanity, nor do you have to project a false image of being a super-Christian. Jesus just wants you to come near as His beloved, even if your heart is pounding.

He wants access to the areas where fear is trying to dominate you. He wants His goodness to affect the things you worry about when you're not at church or in your prayer closet. Jesus wants to position you so He can get the glory out of your mess. And it all starts with you taking a step forward.

In Matthew 26:39, Jesus' anguish in the Garden of Gethsemane reveals how the smallest step forward can reposition you:

And he went a little further, and fell on his face, and prayed ... (KJV)

I love how Jesus only went forward a little

bit. You might be tempted to think your victory is tied to making great leaps forward. But your success doesn't depend on the size of your steps. The key is to get moving.

This reminds me of the famous quote by Dr. Martin Luther King:

If you can't fly, then run. If you can't run, then walk. If you can't walk, then crawl, but whatever you do, you have to keep moving.

King's words remove every excuse for not moving forward. You don't have to worry about God's end of the deal. He's going to do what only He can do. Your job is to keep it moving and follow His lead.

When you're worried ... keep it moving. When your future is threatened ... keep it moving. When your past tries to overtake you ... keep it moving.

No matter what circumstance you're in, God has an answer for you, but you won't connect with it unless you're going forward. Regardless of what your feelings say, you're not trapped; you're just at a crossroads. Choose to go forward. Your miracle is in your movement.

#### Mega Feast Food Distribution

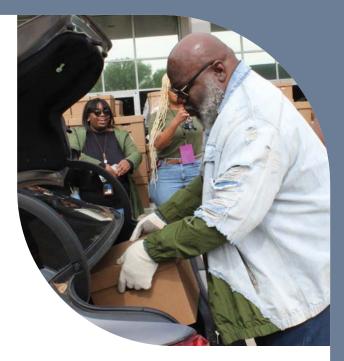
During this year's International Leadership Summit, United MegaCare hosted a community-wide meal distribution event at The Potter's House. The Mega Feast was presented by Wells Fargo.

Post-pandemic food insecurities are still a national problem. As a global humanitarian organization, we are working to "starve the problem, while feeding the solution" by providing low-to-moderate income families with meal boxes to help offset other financial obligations in the home.









We distributed 2,049 family meal boxes, each with enough meat, vegetables, and non-perishable items to feed 5-6 people.

We also partnered with several other nonprofits in the Dallas/Ft. Worth metroplex to distribute additional meal boxes.

We are so thankful for our *GPS* partners who attended and helped us give back to our community.
